- It **might** rain today. (Maybe it will rain today.)
- I **might** be able to help you. (Maybe I will be able to help you.)
- It **may** be easier to do it a different way. (Maybe there is a better way to do this task.)
- I **could** meet you at the metro stop. (Maybe the metro stop would be a good place for us to meet.)
- He **could** come by the office at 5:00pm. (5:00pm might be a good time for him to come to the office.)
- She **may** prefer the blue necklace to the black one. (Maybe she will like the blue necklace more than the black one.)
- The trip **might** take longer than expected. (Maybe it will take longer to arrive at the destination than originally planned).
